The following are suggested formats for general and specific acknowledgments of Country. The specific acknowledgments provided are for the Tasmanian Aboriginal Language Groups of the South-East Nation.

General Acknowledgement of Country

I'd like to begin by acknowledging the Traditional Owners of the land on which we meet today. I would also like to pay my respects to Elders past and present.

Specific Acknowledgement of Country

I'd like to begin by acknowledging the Traditional Owners of the land on which we meet today, the (people) of the (nation) and pay my respects to Elders past and present.

Specific Huon Valley Acknowledgement of Country

I'd like to begin by acknowledging the Traditional Owners of the land on which we meet today, the Melukerdee People of the South East Nation and pay my respects to Elders past and present.

Specific Hobart - Sullivans Cove Acknowledgement of Country

I'd like to begin by acknowledging the Traditional Owners of the land on which we meet today, the Mouheneene People of the South East Nation and pay my respects to Elders past and present.

Specific Bruny Island Acknowledgement of Country

I'd like to begin by acknowledging the Traditional Owners of the land on which we meet today, the Nuenone People of the South East Nation and pay my respects to Elders past and present.

Specific South of Recherche Bay Acknowledgement of Country
